When architectural "detail" is limited, and so is the budget, paint the ceiling and "wrap" down sides 12" to 15". Then, trim out at the stopping location with a simple piece of molding around perimeter of room. Then paint the molding the same as the other trim in room. Continue with your selected wall color under the molding piece.

This gives the illusion of a taller ceiling, which makes the room appear larger and adds interest with out the cost if crown molding or additional ceiling detail.

This works best in a room that would be square or rectangle. It would not work as well in a room with angles.
